- 1. RULES
- As described in SC.
- 2. CLASSES AND ENTRY FEES:
- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats of these classes:

SunFast 20	US\$80

- 2.3. SunFast 20 boats are available from Lagoon Sailboat Rentals. Contact caribsailing@gmail.com for details and booking.
- 2.4. Boats of different classes may be combined and scored using Portsmouth Yardstick at the sole discretion of the organiser.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entries must be made on the Regatta website.
- 3.2. Entrants are requested to notify the organiser of their t-shirt size 5 days before registration.

Mixed windward/leeward, trapezoid and other laid courses in Simpson Bay and/or Simpson Bay Lagoon.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1. SunFast 20 Class: Rule 44 one turn,
- 6.2. All other classes: Rule 44 two turns.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Races required to constitute a series: 3.
- 7.2. Scores excluded: as described in SC.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. In each class: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- 8.2. Additional prizes may be awarded.
