1. Entry
  - 1.1. Entry fees listed above are for each day of racing.
  - 1.2. Entry fees for under 19 apply only if all crew of the boat are under 19.
  - 1.3. Entry fees do not include boat rental.
  - 1.4. Boats can enter online at the Entry and Results page.
  - 1.5. Payment can be made on the day of racing to the SMYC office.
2. Registration - Instead of a formal registration, information about individual race days will be published on the Entry and Results page.
3. Courses will be a mixture of windward-leeward and composite courses starting and finishing in or near Simpson Bay or Simpson Bay Lagoon.
4. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Entry and Results page.
5. Scoring
  - 5.1. Fifteen races are required to be completed to constitute a series. This changes SC 17.1.
  - 5.2. Scoring will be by the CHIPS-3 high-point system which awards scores based on class size.
  - 5.3. A boat that does not start or does not compete will be scored 0 (zero) points. This changes Rule A4.2 and Rule A9.
  - 5.4. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the number of her worst scores no greater than the number of races completed divided by five. This changes SC 17.2.
