6. Start and Finish line description:

- 6.1. The location of the start line is between the outermost red and green channel marks of Gustavia - G1 and G2 as shown on the attached chart.
- 6.2. The finish line will be
 - a) between an orange or blue flag on a committee boat and a nearby orange or black and white chequered mark or a navigation mark, or
 - b) between two marks which may be navigation marks
- 6.3. The committee boat for finishing may not be the same as the committee boat for starting.
- 6.4. The description of the finish line will be announced at the Skippers' Briefing.

7. Classes, Class flags, Starting Procedure:
