

Addendum B for Start Boat A classes CSA 2-8

Addendum to Sailing Instructions for the Afternoon Race Saturday March 2nd, 2013

These instructions shall apply to boats in classes CSA Monohull 2 - 8 only and are in addition to, not in substitution for, the general St. Maarten Heineken Regatta 2013 Sailing Instructions.

When there is a conflict between the general Sailing Instructions and this Addendum, this Addendum shall apply.

1. Schedule of Races

- 1.1 The first warning signal for the second race on Saturday will not be before 13.00h.
- 1.2 It is intended that there will be one windward/leeward race sailed on Saturday afternoon, March 2nd, 2013 after the first race.
- 1.3 The classes and starting order will be:

Order	Class
1	CSA 2
2	CSA 3
3	CSA 4
4	CSA 5
5	CSA 6
6	CSA 7
7	CSA 8

2. Courses and Marks

- 2.1 The racing area will be located north of Marigot, in the Anguilla Channel.
- 2.2 The course, indicated by a numeral pennant will be:

Course	Marks
1	1. WM - round to port 2. Offset M - round to port
2	1. WM - round to port 2. Offset M - round to port 3. LM - round to port 4. WM - round to port 5. Offset M - round to port

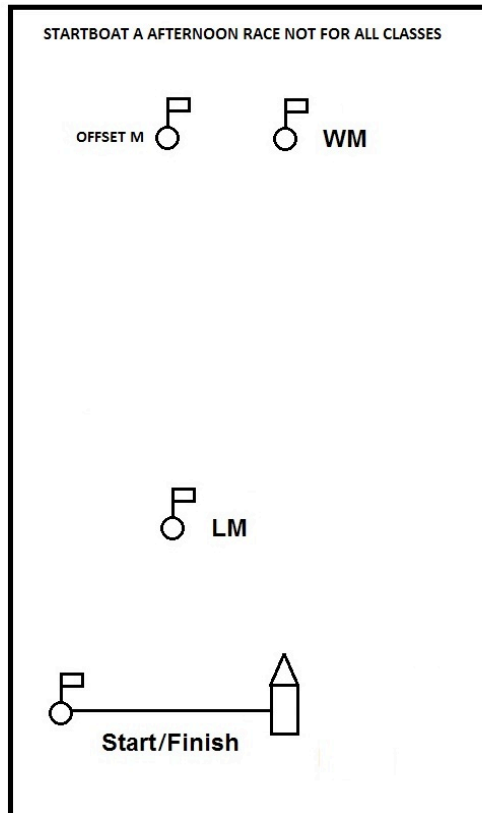
- 2.6 The approximate bearing to the windward mark may be displayed on a board on the Start/Finish Boat. Bearing and distances may be broadcast on VHF channel 71.

3. Start / Finish

- 3.1 The start line will be between an orange flag on the Start/Finish Boat and a nearby yellow mark.
- 3.2 The finish line will be between a blue flag on the Start/Finish Boat and a nearby yellow mark.

4. Time Limit

- 4.1 The time limit for each class for the windward/leeward race shall be 50% of the elapsed time of the first boat, in its class, which finished.
- 4.2 Boats failing to finish by the time limit will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS Rules 35, A4 and A5.
