Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. CSA Minimum Safety Requirements applies.
- 1.3. The Sailing Instructions may also change other rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats registered with IO Race.

3. SCHEDULE of EVENTS and RACING

- 3.1. See Information Attachment.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration and may be available on the regatta website.

5. THE SAILING AREA

- 5.1. The regatta will be held in the waters surrounding St Martin.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1. For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 6.2. The Protest Committee may, at its discretion, impose an alternative penalty in lieu of disqualification for any infringement, including safety requirements, with the exception of an infringement of the Racing Rules parts 1 and 2. This changes RRS 64.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series
- 7.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes will be awarded.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND MEDIA RIGHTS

- 10.1. Competitors grant the Organising Authority the unrestricted right and permission to use the name and the image for any text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event to be published or broadcast in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to press and TV advertisements or internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information; in this respect, competitors names' and any biographical material of themselves may also be used or reproduced in any way known.
